## Itinerary:

Lullington 10.00

All Saints - 6 bells but heavier than ours (Tenor 13cwt, 696 kg)

Netherseal 11.00

St Peter's - 8 bells and heavier than ours (Tenor 11 cwt, 587 kg)

Overseal 12.00

St Matthews- 8 bells a little heavier than ours (Tenor 9 cwt, 496 kg)

John Thompson 1.15pm for lunch

Foremarke 2.45pm

St Saviours - 4 bells a little heavier than ours (Tenor 8 cwt, 437 kg) and this is an anti-clockwise ring.

## Logistics:

Cost: Please bring £1 donation for each tower.

Lunch: The John Thompson does a carvery and also baguettes, jacket spuds and so on, They stop serving food at 2.00. An alternative would be to picnic by the river - just a little farther down the road.

Parking:

Foremark - no problem

Overseal - some parking at the Church Hall on Woodville Rd

Netherseal - roadside by the green.

Lullington - roadside.

**Hartshorne to Lullington** DE12 8EG (8 miles)

From Church Car Park go back to the main A514 and turn left onto Woodville Rd.

At the top of the hill (Clock garage roundabout) take the second exit (left) Moira Rd.

Cross a roundabout second exit.

1.2 miles bear left onto Reservoir Rd

0.3 miles turn right onto Spring Cottage Rd

2.2 miles turn left (sign posted Lullington)



Lullington

**Lullington to Netherseal** DE12 8DF (3 miles)

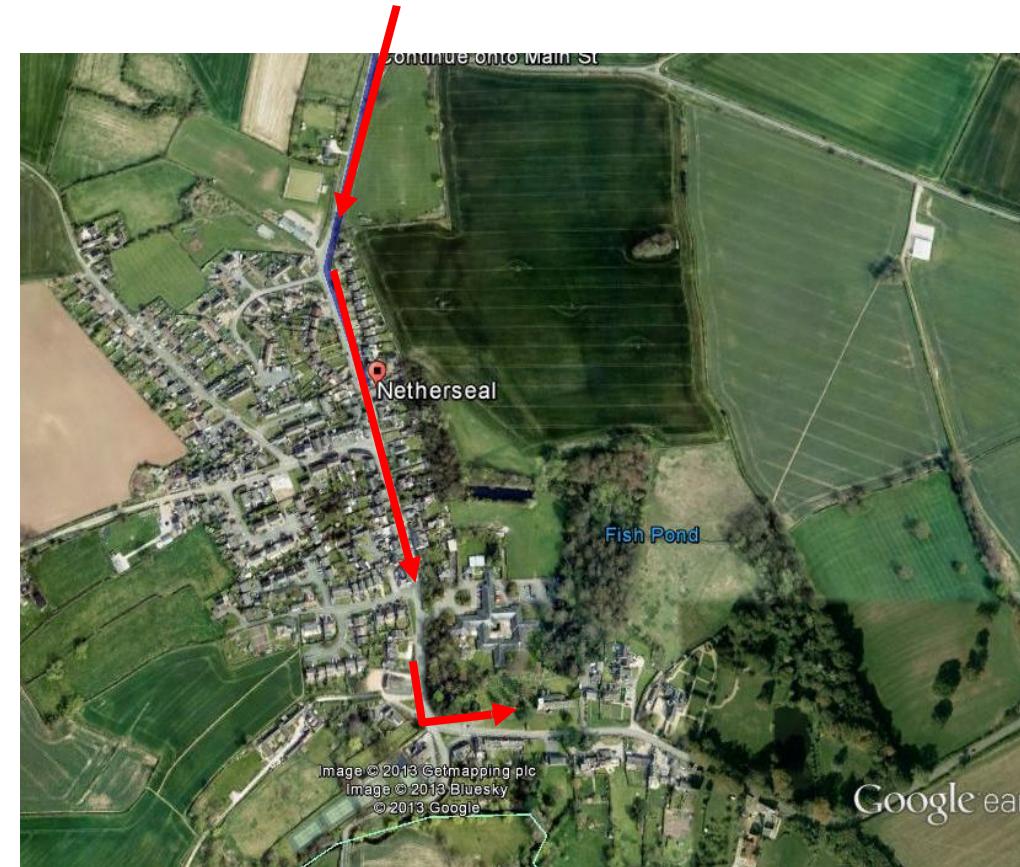
Retrace your steps.

About 1.2 miles turn right

Then 2<sup>nd</sup> right onto Lodge Rd

Right at T junction

Continue right through the village and turn left onto Church Street



Netherseal

**Netherseal to Overseal (2.2 miles) DE12 6LR**

Continue out of the village (with the church on the left)  
At the T junction, turn left onto the A444.  
In Overseal, the church is on the right hand corner at the second cross roads.  
There is parking at the Church Hall (turn right into Woodville Rd, B5004)



**Overseal to the John Thompson (10 miles) DE73 7HW**

Continue up the Woodville Rd (B5004)  
At the junction with the B586, turn left (Reservoir Hill)  
In Woodville at the Clock garage roundabout, take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit to Hartshorne.  
Continue into Ticknall (A514)  
Take the 3<sup>rd</sup> left (Church lane, then Rose lane, then Ingleby Lane). Signed for the village hall.  
This will take you to the pub.
