Letter from Lady Customer to IT Technical Support Department



Dear Tech Support,

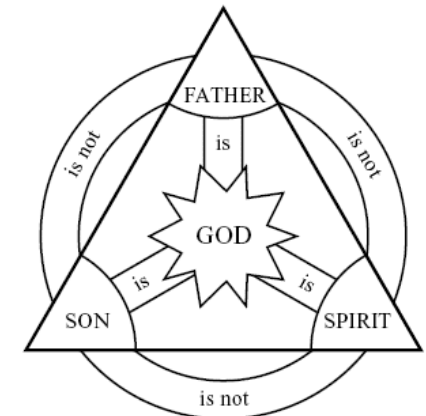
