Yippee, bells back in action!

The two chaps from Taylors Bell Founders have done their work in really good time and refitted the reshaped and re-bushed clappers, inspected and regreased the bell bearings and fitted the repaired pulley from the 3rd bell. Two bearings had to be replaced - one from the treble which is right beside the western louvres and one from the 4th which is close to the eastern louvres. Weather had caused the problem with water ingress leading to some corrosion. We now have Galebreaker fabric over those openings so there should be no repetition of this.

Grateful thanks to the Heritage Lottery Fund and Diocesan Bell Fund who provided the money for this work and to Taylors who carried it out.

Work is starting on the floor under the tenor which will make safe access possible for maintenance and for fitting a muffle. We now need a bit of motorcycle tyre to make the muffle.

Once the floor is in place it will be safe to start cleaning the frame and repainting it. Then we can build the simulator circuits so that extra (silent) practices become possible.
