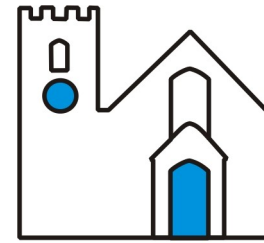

### **MR. JOHN KING FUNERAL OF HARTSHORNE FARMER**

The funeral of Mr. John King (81), of "Sandcliff," Lower Midway, who died on Friday, took place at

Hartshorne Parish Church yesterday. Mr. King was a farmer at Hartshorne and afterwards at Midway for 47 years. His wife died 11 years ago, one son was killed in the war, and two sons and four daughters are bereaved. The Rev. S. W. Bazelgette (rector) officiated.

The mourners were: Mr. and Mrs. G. King, Mr. J. King (sons and daughter-in-law), Mrs A. King, Mrs. S. Kerr (daughters). Mr. W. Hobday (son in-law). Mr. S. Lievesley. Messrs. John and Noel King, Miss M. King, Miss M. Hobday (grandchildren), Mrs. Whetton (niece), Mrs. Johnson (friend), Mr. E. Salt (executor). Mrs. Hobday and Mrs. Lievesley (daughters) were absent through illness. The bearers were Messrs. S. Truman. J. Harvey. T. Bodell and H. Sims.

Philip King, who many of you may know from South Derbyshire Music Centre, has added some more information to this article.

**"John King was my great grandfather and lived at Hoofies Farm. The chief mourners Mr & Mrs G King (our grandparents) lived at Woodlands Farm.**

**E Hobday came to the funeral from Manchester, it is thought, but died while here.**

**Our grandmother's maiden name was Morley and they farmed at Bondwood Farm."**

Longlands Farm, Hartshorne  
Nether Hall, Hartshorne  
Old Hall Farm, Hartshorne  
Several Farm, Hartshorne  
Short Hazels Farm, Hartshorne  
Midway Farm, Midway

After Bretby Hall Estate was sold, the 5th Earl made history as the man who financed the excavations leading to the discovery of Tutankhamen's tomb in 1922.
