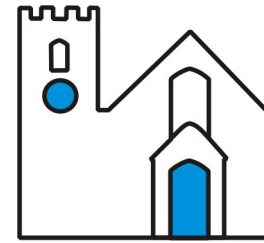

EXTENSIONS**

**APPLICATIONS TO
BURTON COUNCIL**

REMUNERATIVE WORK

Burton Corporation Electricity Committee have received applications from the Hartshorn, Anslow and Stanton areas for a supply of electricity. From Hartshorn 80 residents have applied, and the electrical engineer has advised the committee that as it is desirable to put in a duplicate supply from Woodville to Milton Waterworks, he considers the work would prove remunerative if proceeded with at once.

The cost of the main from Woodville to Hartshorn, which would provide the duplicate main referred to, would be £1,2443, and the low tension supply at Hartshorn would cost £1,110, making a total of £2,3915. To complete the line to Milton would cost £3,996, and a supply could be provided to Milton village, Foremark, and possibly Twyford. The cost of the extension to Ansley is esti-

mated at £847, end the committee recommended that subject to the Corporation being guaranteed revenue up to £2299 per annum the extension should be made.

From the church records:

On 8th May 1930 a faculty was granted for: "installing the necessary wires, fixtures and fittings for lighting by Electricity the church".

Before this the church was lit by paraffin lamps as there was no gas supply to the village.
