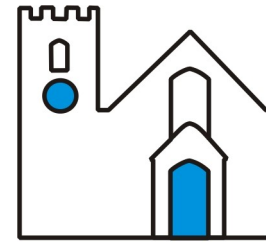

Of special interest is the shelter that Bill has built to demonstrate the importance to the Jews of the Festival of Shelters, as recorded in Leviticus 23:40-43:

⁴⁰ On the first day you are to take branches from luxuriant trees - from palms, willows and other leafy trees - and rejoice before the LORD your God for seven days. ⁴¹ Celebrate this as a festival to the LORD for seven days each year. This is to be a lasting ordinance for the generations to come; celebrate it in the seventh month. ⁴² Live in temporary shelters for seven days: all native-born Israelites are to live in such shelters ⁴³ so that your descendants will know that I made the Israelites live in temporary shelters when I brought them out of Egypt. I am the LORD your God.”
