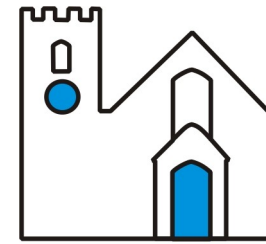
**FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT**
