FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

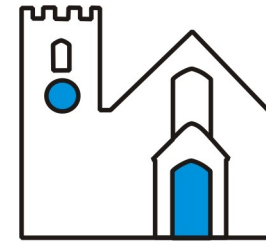
We now have a permanent collection point at church so that we can support the Swadlincote Food Bank throughout the year.

THE JOURNEY OF THE PALM CROSSES

This Palm Sunday think about who made the cross that you are given during the service. The palm crosses are made in seven villages in the Masasi area of Southern Tanzania. The dwarf palms grow wild (not cultivated). They are cut into strips and woven into the cross shape. As they are handmade size varies from lengths of 15cm to 25cm.

Making palm crosses gives extra work to people whose only other source of income is the sale of their cashew nuts. Any money they earn from palm crosses is used for the usual household necessities - clothes for the parents and their children, salt, soap and any money required to get to the nearest hospital for medical treatment.

They are used in churches of all denominations for Palm Sunday services. The crosses are taken on foot by the villagers to a centre in Masasi. They are then transported by road to the nearest port which is either Mtwara or Dar-es-salaam, where they are loaded into containers for shipment to the UK and USA.

SIDES PERSONS

At the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) on 17th April we have to appoint sides persons for the coming year. If you are already on the side persons rota I hope you will be able to continue serving in this way.

Duties include: welcoming people; helping the service run smoothly by assisting with taking the collection and guiding people at communion; counting the number of adults and children attending the service.
