FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

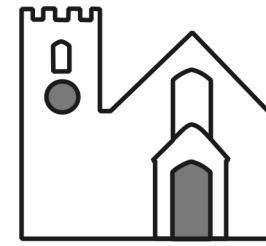
We now have a permanent collection point at church so that we can support the Swadlincote Food Bank throughout the year.

THE BELLS by Jane Horan

Four years ago at one of the weekly Wednesday evening prayer meetings held at church I felt that God was saying that He wanted the bells to be rung out to make people aware of His 'church on the hill'.

There had been no practice nights for the previous ten years or so and the bells had only been rung at weddings. Anthony Cotton, from Derby Diocesan Association of Church Bellringers, and a team of experienced ringers started to teach local people to ring. Andy Austen, from Repton, was appointed Tower Captain and over the past three years has worked tirelessly to get ringing established here at St Peter's and to raise money to pay for the necessary refurbishment of the bells.

Of our regular ringers, five live in the parish and ring regularly on a Sunday morning before the service. Some have no transport and are reliant on getting a lift (usually from Andy). There are four other members of the church (myself included) who cannot regularly ring on a Sunday for one reason or another. It would be really good if we could recruit other members of the church to become bell ringers so that we could have a reliable band of ringers for Sunday mornings.

I myself never thought that I would take up bell ringing after a break of forty years but I literally got 'roped in' and can honestly say that I have really enjoyed the experience. So....
