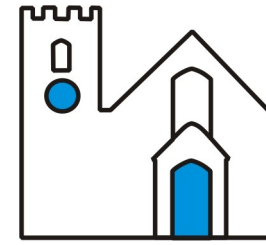
### FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT
