FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

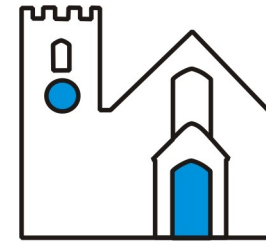
We now have a permanent collection point at church so that we can support the Swadlincote Food Bank throughout the year.

After a break we then split into three groups to compare our visions and headlines. Ideas were freely exchanged and it was interesting to discover how some of our visions were very similar.

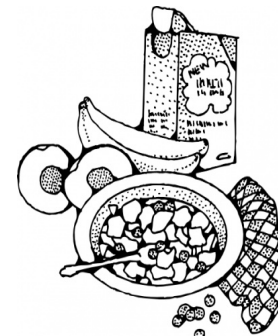
