FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

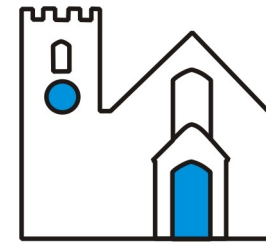
We now have a permanent collection point at church so that we can support the Swadlincote Food Bank throughout the year.

HOW WE CELEBRATED ANOTHER ROYAL EVENT

“On May 27th, a Meeting of the Coronation Committee was held. The donations paid or promised were found to amount to £34 10s 0d. The Committee decided to meet again on Wednesday, June 4th, by which time all contributions must be paid up, in order that it may be ascertained how much money there is to spend, and provision may be made for all who wish to take part in the Coronation Festivities. It is hoped that enough money may be raised to give a free Tea to all the children, and a free Dinner to all others who cannot afford the cost of it themselves. It is also hoped that it may be possible to present a ‘Coronation Mug’ to each child in the parish, the cost of which will amount in all to about £5. Due notice will be given of the arrangements and the hour of the Coronation Service in the Parish Church.”

NB Edward VII's coronation had originally been scheduled for 26th June, but two days before on 24th June, he was diagnosed with appendicitis. Edward was crowned at Westminster Abbey on 9th August 1902.
