### FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

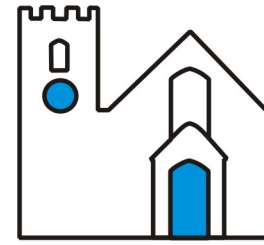
We now have a permanent collection point at church so that we can support the Swadlincote Food Bank throughout the year.

#### **EVACUATION PLANS**

##### **FIRST MEETING OF HARTSHORNE COMMITTEE**

The first meeting of Hartshorne Evacuation Committee was held at the local Church Schools. The billeting officer Mr W Simkin, jun., was in the chair.

Members thought that householders would prefer to feed people who had been evacuated rather than subscribe to communal meals.

It was decided that the formation of washing and mending parties was not necessary at the present time, but that they could be organised if required.

The committee also decided that home nursing classes were needed, and the secretary, Mr. R.B. Lea, was instructed to write to Repton Rural Council suggesting that classes should be started in October.
