### FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

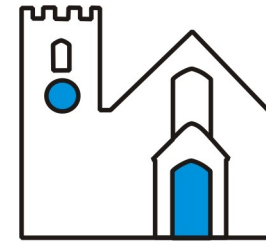
We now have a permanent collection point at church so that we can support the Swadlincote Food Bank throughout the year.

## A personal story of one of the men named on Hartshorne's war memorial

ALBERT EDWARD WEBSTER and Annie Ruth Webster, when first married, lived on Cinder Hill, Hartshorne. Soon after the birth of their first daughter, Betty, they moved to Baldwin's Row, Hartshorne. Albert was a staff sergeant in the army (pictured top right). He was invalided out, having been injured whilst serving in the Great War.

Afterwards he obtained work at Rawdon Colliery. Three or four men worked as a team. They were paid on the basis of what coal they produced. They worked a part of the coal face which was called a 'stall'. The money earned was shared equally between the men who worked on the stall. Because of his injuries Albert did not work hard enough to

satisfy one of the team in particular, who objected to giving him an equal share of the money.

Albert died aged 25, leaving a wife, with no income, and two little girls.

"The most significant and traumatic time for me happened during these years. My dad died in the February as I was to be five in the June. He never recovered from injuries received when he was fighting in Northern Ireland. When his body was lying in the front room at home, I went into the garden and picked a bunch of snowdrops and put them in his hand. To me it seemed as if he was asleep."
