# My Training - Autumn Term update

I've now completed my first term\*, and about to embark on my 2<sup>nd</sup> term, God willing financially and emotionally. It's not been an altogether easy journey, as at times I have struggled with understanding and getting through each week's homework and the assignments.

It was whilst undertaking one of these assignments that I actually 'saw' the strength of our Church here at St Peter's. I had to complete an audit of our Church, looking back over the last 10 years. When I first came to St Peter's; under the last Vicar; the Church was quite full and had a strong young content amongst the congregation. For various reasons the congregation dwindle over time, and the young content became quite light.

Watching this happen, looking only at the Sunday attendance, gives a view that our Church doesn't have the strength it needs for growth. However, looking at what was and is now, I realised it's not necessarily quantity that will make the Church grow, it's quality. Quality of those in the Church ready and willing to spread God's word, and to work endlessly to make the love of Christ known to as many as we can touch as possible.

There is so much going on within this congregation, and sometimes not taken on board or noticed. Whilst the numbers of young people have dwindle within our congregation, this is possibly happening in other Churches. With this in mind, with the wonderful leaders of

the young we do have, and needing access to the youth of Swadlincote, the vision for an outreach to the young was born! So we have YFC (Youth for Christ). This has grown immensely over time, with football academies, a Youth Alpha Course and input into the local schools.

Over the last few years MIF (Men in Faith) has formed, and there's a men's prayer breakfast as a way of inviting the community to share food and time with Christ. Not to be left out, we then had the forming of the Women's prayer breakfast where they incorporated a craft morning. This resulted in the craft fair, where monies raised was used for the community.


We then, for the first time this year; Christmas 2016; collaborated with the Admiral Rodney for a Carol Service outside the pub around a Christmas tree. The leader was very good and inspiring, and it was so successful he couldn't wait to call for this to be an annual event. What a wonderful way to reach out to people with God's love.

Our toy service has been inspiring to see each year, and also part of this input and the need to reach out elsewhere, has seen Helen; part of Coventry Mission; join Graham (Youth Leader) working with YFC.

We now have a café run alongside the Post Office, offering free tea/ coffee and the sharing of God's love amongst others.

There is much more than that going on, but one thing was truly clear to

me; having undertaken this audit; we ARE a growing Church. Maybe not in quantities at the moment, but certainly in the quality of outreach many of us are involved in to share the love of God, the light of Christ and the peace of the Holy Spirit with all we meet.
