FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

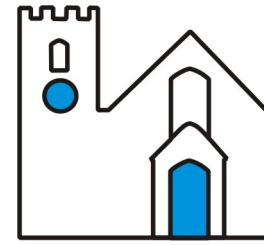
We now have a permanent collection point at church so that we can support the Swadlincote Food Bank throughout the year.

Appointment to Newhall

We are pleased to announce that Rev Patrick Douglas, currently Pioneer Assistant Curate in the Walbrook Epiphany Team Ministry Derby, has been appointed as Priest-in-Charge of St John's Newhall, and Pioneer Minister of Swadlincote Bishop's Mission Order.

In this post, Patrick will be working both as Priest-in-Charge of Newhall, and also as a Pioneer Minister across the Swadlincote area. As Priest-in-Charge, Patrick will be responsible for leading and developing the life and worship of St John's.

As Pioneer Minister, Patrick will be seeking to develop the existing work of the local churches with families, young people and children, to make disciples and form congregations or a Fresh Expression. This will be a role that works with, supports and builds upon the work that the local churches and Christian groups have undertaken. This is an exciting new development for the Swadlincote area and one which will require our prayerful support. Patrick is hoping to be licensed to the post as soon as practicable.
