Dear Friends at St Peter's,

Thank you for your support of Coventry City Mission's Giving Tree project at Christmas. We were able to support nearly 450 children and young people across Coventry who would otherwise have received very little or nothing for Christmas.

In the run up to Christmas we met the families whom we were supporting and heard the reasons behind why they needed help. We were able to help a refuge that supports women dealing with domestic violence, and provided gifts for all of the children living there. We also heard of families who in the past had chosen between having a Christmas dinner and buying gifts, these families said that now they could do both as we provided the gifts for them.

We also supported a grandmother who had moved her grandchildren in to live with her to prevent them from being taken into care, families living in hotels because they had been made homeless and other families struggling for a variety of reasons.

Just before Christmas the families came to collect the toy sacks. Many brought their children with them, so that they could take part in art and craft activities and receive selection boxes, which had been donated, from Father Christmas.

Thank you for your support at Christmas 2016. It made a huge difference to many families across Coventry. We really could not have done it without your support.
