FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

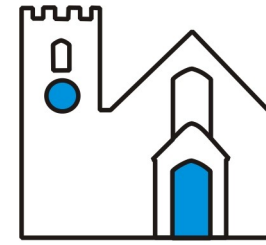
We now have a permanent collection point at church so that we can support the Swadlincote Food Bank throughout the year.

ITEMS FOR SYRIA

Gwen has been knitting items for the charity GREENFIELDS AFRICA for some time and has recently received a request for items for Syria.

“Some of our stocks of baby clothing and blankets, together with the shoes we couldn’t ship to Kenya, have already been received in Syria and have been greatly welcomed.

To that end I am now asking that if you would like to help with this project we should be delighted to receive your knitting again.

Their requirements are slightly different, as you would expect. They would like:

1. Bed blankets. These can be 2 blankets 1m square stitched together. Mixed colours and designs are fine. If the sewing is a problem, then please send as singles and we will sew together. Crocheted blankets are excellent.

2. Jumpers, scarves and hats to fit from primary children up to and including adult would make such a difference to their lives. Any other knits are good too, I mention jumpers as they are easier than cardigans. Their needs are manifold.”

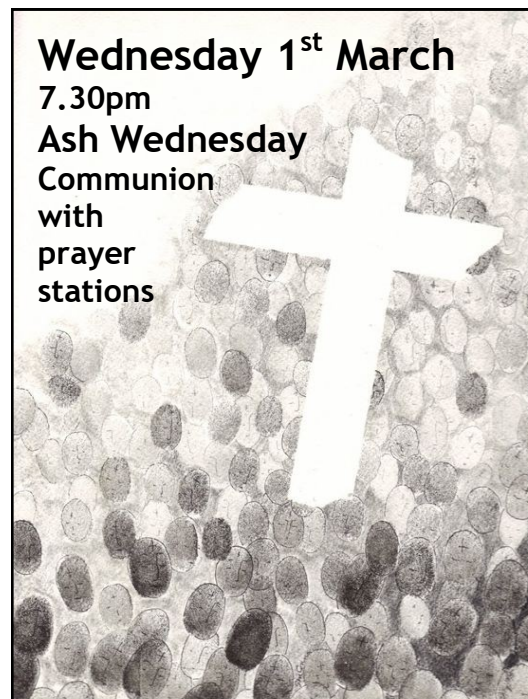
