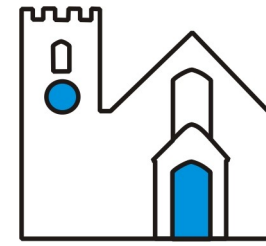
### FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

## Appreciations and reflections of an Ordinand

It has been 18 months since we first joined the church here at St Peter's as part of my ordination training. Coming from an evangelical/charismatic church tradition and having worked previously with Graham, it has been relatively easy to be among those who are like-minded. The level of attentiveness to people joining any church is probably one of the most significant factors in their continued involvement.

I have been very grateful and felt privileged for the opportunity to serve the church on Sundays, with the intercessions, Holy Communion, leading and preaching. I am also thankful for the experience of the Willington mission day and hospitality of the Friday house group. These have been very encouraging and helpful in my learning. The forming of the Mission Action Plan and its ongoing implementation and development is clearly having a good impact on the church as it seeks to show God's love to the people of Hartshorne and all those who it comes into contact with. The scripture is true, where there is vision people flourish.

A personal challenge has been that due to the time constraints imposed by being full-time at theological college, I have not been able to engage more deeply. Positively, I have observed that the church in my time here has grown in confidence after a difficult time and is beginning to emerge with a different flavour, new creativity, reorientation and a fresh experience of God's grace in people's lives. With Stella coming as a curate and as new people join you, my prayer is that God will give you wisdom in all you do, revelation that you may know him better and you will continually know the hope to which he has called you.

We will be transitioning again from July to St Mary's Church in Boulton, Derby, where there is a strong evangelical tradition and very active community involvement. I hope to be both continually learning and bringing some of my own gifts and experience in this new context. Though I will be in the Derby City Deanery we will still be part of the same Diocese, and hopefully be able to connect again in the future. In the meantime, we would appreciate your prayers for this new phase of our lives.
