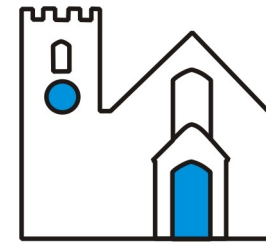
FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

10 Main Street, Hartshorne DE11 7ES

Hall and kitchen range of substantial early 17th century timber framed manor house. Well preserved, with decorative framing, two storey porch, ovens and cellars. (Parlour wing now in separate occupation and not open.) Still lived in as a private house. Stable and early 20th century wash house.

Garden including over 200 period plants labelled with historic uses. Tudor/Stuart era toys and games to try out. Demonstrations of lace-making and spinning. Costumed guides.
