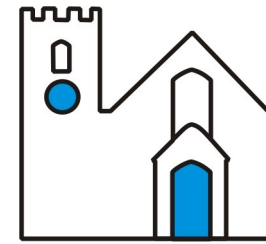
FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

Memories of the church as recalled by John Smith
(found when looking through some paperwork)

“When I was 5 years old in 1944 the SUNDAY SCHOOL met from 3-4pm at the rear of the church. I was taught by the Rev Bridge, Lois Bailey and Edith Brooks. I can remember some of the others who attended, Graham Blood, Charlie and George Bannister, Alan Dolman, John Chevin, Peter Warren, George Bates, Peter Day, John Wilkins, Ray Wagstaff and girls.

I joined the CHOIR when I was 10 years old. The practice was on a Thursday in the Old Rectory in Church Street at 7.30pm. It was led by Rector Logan. There were about 30 in the choir at that time. We took part in the morning and evening services. Everyone moved up from the Sunday School at 10 years of age and joined the choir. They left at 14 years of age. Other members of the choir at that time included Mary Boffey, George Bexon and Arthur Raynor.

The ALTAR/COMMUNION TABLE was presented by the Orme family well known in the village for running the village bakery and store. This presentation took place in the time of Rev Brown and was given in memory of William and Eleanor Orme by Jim, Bill, Tom and Kate Orme.”
