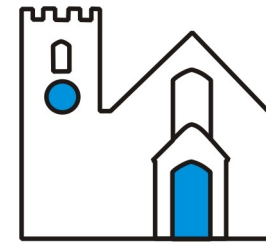
FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT
