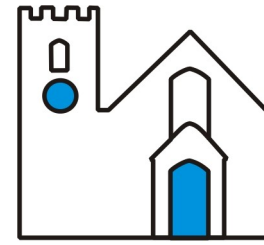
FOOD BANK COLLECTION POINT

I've completed my 1st term of the 2nd year for training. My next issue, besides getting better and able to drive, is getting the car repaired as this decided to come out in sympathy with me and is also in need of serious TLC: so prayers I can find the money before I'm ready to drive would be appreciated.
