FOOD BANK

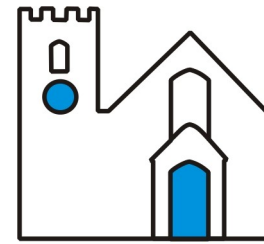
COLLECTION POINT

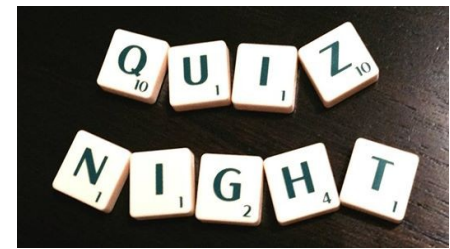


KNITWITS held its first meeting on Saturday 3rd February, when wool and instructions for knitting Angels was dispensed.
