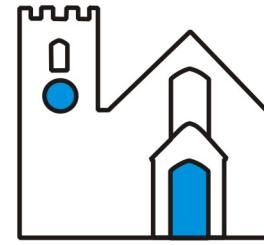

10 Quotes from Billy Graham on Easter

Billy Graham had a lot to say over the years about Christ's death and resurrection – what he called the two “most important events in human history.” Here are some quotes from 60 years of ministry.



1918 - 2018

“Without the resurrection, the cross is meaningless.”

“The cross shows us the seriousness of our sin – but it also shows us the immeasurable love of God.”

“God proved His love on the Cross. When Christ hung, and bled, and died, it was God saying to the world, ‘I love you.’”

“Why is it that the cross has become the symbol of Christianity? It is because at the cross Jesus purchased our redemption and provided a righteousness which we could not ourselves earn.”

“It was not the people of the Roman soldiers who put [Jesus] on the cross – it was your sins and my sins that made it necessary for Him to volunteer His death.”

“When Jesus hung on the cross, a great unseen cosmic battle raged in the heavens – and in the end, Christ triumphed over all the forces of evil and death and hell.”

“Sin's masterpiece of shame and hate became God's masterpiece of mercy and forgiveness. Through the death of Christ upon the cross, sin itself was crucified for those who believe in Him.”

“It has been said there was a cross in the heart of God long before the cross was erected at Calvary. As we think about it we will be overwhelmed at the wonder and greatness of His love for us.”

“The resurrection of Christ changed the midnight of bereavement into a sunrise of reunion; it changed the midnight of disappointment into a sunrise of joy; it changed the midnight of fear to a sunrise of peace.”

“Christ broke the bonds of death by His resurrection, and from that moment on, Satan was a defeated foe.”
