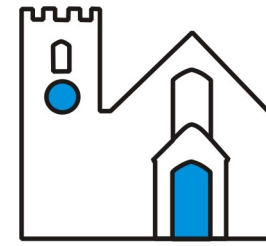

The Cross in my Pocket

Those of you who came to the Good Friday service of reflection may remember that we were invited to take a small wooden cross and think about what it meant to us. After the service I put the cross in my coat pocket. A few days later we set off for two weeks on the boat. It was very cold so while walking along the towpath I wore my coat and, needing to keep warm, I dug my hand in my pocket. My fingers touched an object that I did not at first recognise but I quickly identified that small wooden cross. It was comforting to feel its shape and I felt very close to Jesus.



The Cross in my Pocket poem came to mind:

I carry a cross in my pocket,
A simple reminder to me
That I am a Christian,
No matter where I may be.

This little cross isn't magic,
Nor is it a good luck charm.
It isn't meant to protect me
From every physical harm.

It's not for identification
For all the world to see.
It's simply an understanding
Between my Saviour and me.

When I put my hand in my pocket
To bring out a coin or a key,
The cross is there to remind me
Of the price He paid for me.

It reminds me too, to be thankful
For my blessings every day,
And to strive to serve Him better
In all that I do or say.

It's also a daily reminder
Of the peace and comfort I share
With all who know my Master
And give themselves to His care.

So, I carry a cross in my pocket
Reminding none but me
That Jesus Christ is Lord of my life,
If only I'll let Him be.
