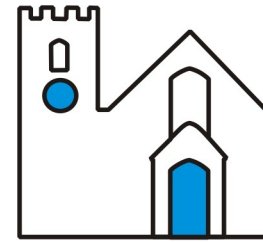

UPDATE ON CHURCH HALL WORK PARTY

At yesterday's work party fourteen adults and two children came along to the church hall to help with decorating and DIY. Thank you to all those who helped in any way.

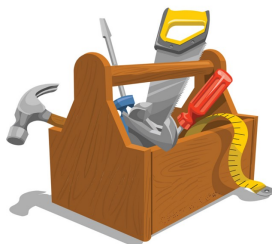


The walls in the ladies' and disabled toilets were given a coat of white emulsion to freshen up the darker, cold shade of turquoise. Some woodwork was also painted in gloss. We will need to give the walls a further coat of paint when dry and complete painting the doors and skirting boards.

The area at the other end of the hall, where Little Sparks store toys and equipment, has now been partitioned off with a stud wall and double doors. This will provide more secure storage and look a lot neater. The walls and woodwork still have to be painted.

The office has now lost a wall of cupboards and has now been refitted with shelving and space to stack chairs - making the hall less cluttered. Hopefully it will now be easier to find less frequently used items such as Christmas decorations which were previously buried under piles of boxes!

The next WORK PARTY is taking place on SATURDAY 6th APRIL. We hope to complete the painting on that day and also go out into the community to clean the road signs which are very dirty and difficult to read. Please make a note of the date so that you can come along to help - if you don't do decorating then serving refreshments and washing up is just as helpful!
