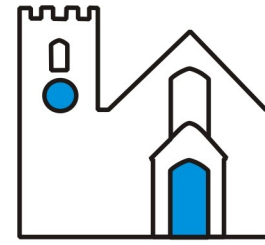

## THESE THEY HAVE LOVED

A couple of months ago when I was sorting through the drawers in the church hall kitchen I rediscovered a recipe book entitled THESE THEY HAVE LOVED that had been written by Sheila Eames the school cook at Eureka primary school many years ago. I first met Sheila when my eldest child started at the preschool there at the age of four. Sheila was a lovely caring lady who had a word of encouragement for everyone she met. It was Sheila who first invited me to come to Hartshorne Church - she said it was a friendly church where the gospel was preached. That was nearly 34 years ago and I'm still here.

I pondered on the significance of finding this recipe book and it came to me that it was almost like Sheila leaving a legacy that would carry on long after our first meeting. Sadly she died in 2017. Over the years she never stopped loving and sharing the Lord with everyone. I remember her unstinting service in many ways. She cooked the pudding for the Alpha Course which I collected week after week. She had a wonderful rapport with children - I remember her reminiscing about her childhood when she got up to all sorts of naughty tricks. I am sure many will have been touched by the stories she told.

The recipe book that Sheila wrote contained favourites from the school dinner menu and I been trying some of the recipes out. Here is her recipe for Gainsboro' Tart which you may have sampled at cafe church last week.

### Gainsboro' Tart

Line tin with shortcrust pastry, spread on jam.

#### Filling

7 ozs. Marg.

7 ozs. Sugar

7 ozs. Ground rice

7 ozs. Coconut

1 tsp. Baking powder

1½ Eggs

a little milk to give a soft dropping consistency.

Cream marg., sugar and eggs. Add ground rice, coconut and baking powder. Add milk and mix well. Portion into tin and spread out. Bake Gas 5, Electric 375 deg. F, 190 deg. C. for about 30 minutes.

N.B. I used a packet of ready rolled pastry (just the right size for a swiss roll tin), a jar of home made blackcurrant jam and 2 eggs.
