CORONAVIRUS LATEST GUIDANCE FOR CHURCHES



Individuals should continue to follow good hygiene practices, using tissues to catch coughs and sneezes and binning the tissues, and keeping hands clean by washing thoroughly for at least 20 seconds or using hand-sanitiser with minimum 60% alcohol content.

In light of the continued increase of Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases in the United Kingdom, Church of England guidance is to **suspend the administration of the chalice** as well as physical contact during the sharing of the Peace, blessing or "laying on of hands".

We advise that all priests should:

- **Offer Communion in one kind only** to all communicants i.e. the consecrated bread/wafer/host, with the priest alone taking the wine;
- **Suspend handshaking or other direct physical contact during the sharing of the Peace;**
- **Suspend direct physical contact as part of a blessing or "laying on of hands".**

While the number of believers in Yemen (number 8 on the World Watch List) is growing, most have to keep their faith a complete secret. Leaving Islam is forbidden, and so believers from Muslim backgrounds run the risk of honour-killing or physical violence if their families or communities discover their faith. Open Doors supports believers on the Arabian Peninsula through prayer and distributing Bibles and other Christian literature, as well as training believers and pastors.

Heavenly Father, pour out Your peace and Your healing over Yemen. Protect believers who are meeting secretly to worship You, and strengthen those who are despairing at the ongoing war. Unite

Christians as the body of Christ despite the separation and isolation. Amen.
