Hello everyone

You will, by now have heard from the government that Hartshorne, along with the rest of Derbyshire will emerge from lockdown this week into Tier 3 of restrictions. In all tiers, churches can open for services as long as people do not mix with anyone not in their household or bubble. We do, therefore, need to prayerfully assess whether opening is the right thing to do for our parish and our community.

The reason that we are being placed in tier 3 is that while the numbers have dropped slightly recently, there are still very high level of infections and we need to ensure that the vulnerable members of our community are safe. The leadership team will be meeting early next week to confirm what we believe is the right way forward. I will then update you all next week.

Whether we meet in person or remain on-line, God remains with us and welcomes our worship in whatever form that takes.

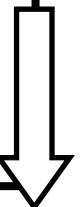

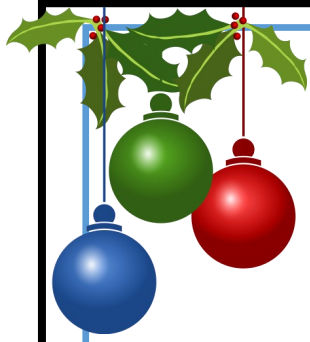
As we emerge from the second lockdown and enter Advent, we look for the coming of Christ and of his Kingdom, and the hope that gives us.
