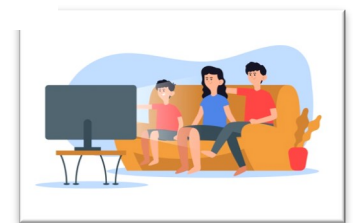
## After church coffee

Community testing for  
COVID-19

Community testing for COVID-19 is now available in Swadlincote.

The testing will identify people with COVID-19, enable support for those who have to self-isolate, and drive infection rates down further in the county. It will also help our public health team to understand the prevalence of people who are infected but without symptoms. By finding out who has the virus the chain of transmission can then be broken, resulting in far fewer people being infected. Community testing is not for those who have coronavirus symptoms. They should book a test in the usual way.

- Grove Hall, Grove Street, Swadlincote
- Midway Community Centre, Chestnut Ave, Swadlincote
- Gresley Old Hall, Gresley Wood Road, Swadlincote
