A thought from Debbie

If you were to more consciously think of Jesus as the Bread of Life, how would that alter the way you relate to him?

For me, I can often fall into the habit of thinking that I am very capable of looking after myself. I know what I need and when I need it...'if I need God's help, I will ask Him for it'.

But in John 6 Jesus describes himself as *living bread* he even goes as far as to say 'I am the bread of life'.

In this frame, I wonder if I am often putting myself on a bread diet... only letting myself eat when I am starving.

Prayer for the week

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Dear Lord Jesus
Today, and every day, I choose to feast on your
goodness in prayer and in reading my Bible.
As in Psalm 34, remind me Lord that I must
'taste and see that the Lord is good'.
Thank you for feeding my body and soul. Amen

Jesus reminds his listeners that the Israelites, on their slow journey to the promised land, had to collect the bread from heaven every morning! and in the prayer that Jesus taught his disciples to use he said 'give us this day our daily bread'.

So, I am learning that I need to give myself a DAILY meal of this bread from heaven... our lovely Lord Jesus.
