# A thought from Mike

Psalm 1: 'That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season'

Advice from RHS: 'Trees and shrubs provide height, so give an extra dimension to your garden. With careful selection they can also provide colour for seasonal interest throughout the year whether with flowers, fruit, autumn leaves or winter silhouettes.

Select the right size and number of trees to fit with the size of your garden, bearing in mind the mature height and spread. Look to have one or two trees in a small to medium garden. Too many trees or potentially large trees may outgrow their space.'

Great advice from a fantastic organisation... but how do we become people planted like trees by steams of water? Let's see if we can work out together how to become these people on Sunday.
