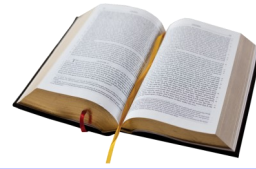

A thought from Sandra

How far are we prepared to go on the path of discipleship? Would we still be faithful even if it meant losing our lives? For many Christians around the world, this is a very real possibility. No doubt we feel sorry for Christians who face loss of employment, imprisonment or death because they are Christians, but when they are asked how we can support them in prayer the answer given is often not that their persecution should end but that we should pray for strength for them to face it, and that they will always stay faithful.

If you want to be inspired by stories of how that commitment is worked out in the lives of many of our brothers and sisters around the world, then come along on Sunday and hear more.

Open Doors originated in 1955, when a young  **Open Doors** Dutchman started smuggling Bibles to the persecuted church in Communist Europe. He became known as Brother Andrew, and his work led to more than six decades of support for the persecuted church around the world.

Every month 10% of the money **Church Giving** given to St Peter's church is shared between the following charities:
