Repair Cafe Woodville is volunteer powered and is designed to help members of our community to repair, reuse, and recycle.

This helps prevent items being thrown out needlessly and saves the cost of buying a replacement. It's better for the

environment too with less materials and energy needed to make new goods.

Volunteer repairers can tackle small electrical items such as toasters, hairdryers, lamps, radios and headphones. Clothing, garden tools, bikes, computers, hand tools and small items of furniture can also be considered for repair.

The repair service is free but donations are very welcome. An important aspect of the work of repair cafés is about empowering people to be able to do their own repairs in the future. Where possible you'll sit with the repairer and learn from them. This may be something like replacing a fuse, mending a ripped jacket or cleaning an item to keep it working properly. People cannot leave items and then pick them up later.


