CAP money coach

Are you interested in being trained to become a CAP (Christians against Poverty) money coach?

There has never been a greater need for managing our money, especially with the many changes in the benefits system this year.

CAP Money is a money management course that gives people an opportunity to spend time looking and thinking about their personal and family finances. It will help them to prepare a budget and gives advice and help on how to stick with it.

It is supported by excellent materials, a workbook and an on-line budgeting tool, and is run by trained money coaches. CAP Money also gives an opportunity, where appropriate, to introduce the Christian message and pray for those who come on the course.
