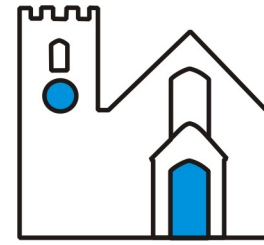

SEASONAL RECIPES Why not try making these recipes? You may have sampled them at church or maybe at the Light Party. Stella is looking for help with this year's Light Party so would appreciate donations of soup.

Apple Flapjacks

This recipe is great if you're looking to use up seasonal apples. Make this delicious, moist flapjack for an afternoon treat and wash it down with a hot cup of tea!



Ingredients

250g (8oz) butter	250g (8oz) caster sugar
175g (6oz) golden syrup	300g (10oz) porridge oats
250g (8oz) Self Raising Flour	2 apples, peeled and chopped

Preheat oven to Gas Mark 4, 180°C, fan 160°C. Line a 20 x 30cm (8 x 12in) cake tin with non-stick baking paper.

Melt butter, caster sugar and golden syrup together in a pan, stirring until sugar has dissolved. Remove from heat and stir in oats, flour and apples.

Spread mixture in tin and bake for 30 minutes. Cut into 12-14 bars; allow to cool before turning out of the tin.

Roasted Pumpkin Soup

This recipe is good for using up the scooped out flesh of the pumpkin you have carved.



Ingredients

1.5kg pumpkin	Olive oil
1 tablespoon Cajun spice mix	1 large onion
3 cloves garlic	1 carrot
1 stick of celery	1 litre hot vegetable stock

Preheat the oven to 170°C. Remove the seeds from the pumpkin flesh (you can keep these for roasting), then chop into wedges. Place the pumpkin on two large baking trays and drizzle over a little olive oil. Sprinkle the Cajun spice over the pumpkin with some black pepper. Roast the pumpkin for 40 hours, or until soft and slightly caramelised at the edges.

Meanwhile, roughly chop the onion, garlic, carrot and celery. Heat a lug of olive oil over a medium heat in a large saucepan then add the vegetables and cook for 15 minutes, or until soft and sweet but not coloured.

When the squash is ready, add to the pan with the hot stock. Blend with a stick blender, adding a little more water if you like a thinner consistency.

Ladle into bowls and add your favourite toppings.
