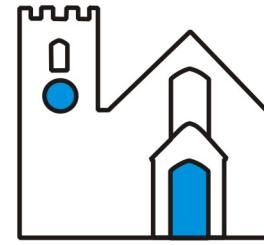

STANDING STRONG CONFERENCE

A message from Sandra

To all who have booked a place at Open Doors' celebration event Standing Strong on Saturday 17 November. Standing Strong offers a unique opportunity to hear from speakers from North Korea, India and Egypt who can speak authoritatively and inspirationally on the persecuted church.

Doors and registration will open at 9am. Please bring your ticket with you, which I will give you shortly.

Refreshments (tea/coffee) are included in the price of your ticket. If you haven't pre-ordered a grab-bag lunch, you are very welcome to bring your own food and drink with you; there will also be a café open from 12:30pm at Bethel Convention Centre selling drinks and snacks.

There is very limited parking at Bethel Convention Centre (BCC) and it is expected the car park will be full by 9.15am. An overflow car park is located at Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council, Dudley Road, Oldbury B69 3DL. Please note all day parking costs £4 and the car park is open from 8am-6pm. Street parking is also available on Kelvin Way which is the road that runs alongside Bethel Convention Centre. Please do not park on yellow lines or red routes.

If the car park is full upon arrival at the BCC, a member of staff will be waiting and will provide you with directions to the overflow car park. You can walk from here to the BCC in 20 minutes or alternatively take one of the free shuttle buses we will provide. Please park your car and wait by the parking barriers where you'll find the shuttle buses and an Open Doors staff member to help you.

In the run up to the event, please be praying for all those involved - especially our brothers and sisters travelling from places where faith costs the most.

If you haven't yet received information about lifts, please have a word me.

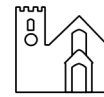
