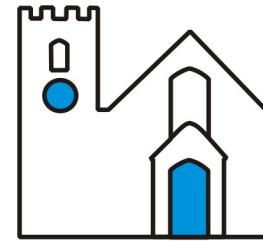

### Last week's PICTURE QUIZ

This was inspired by Gina who mentioned that she had told her granddaughter that a railway bridge used to cross Hartshorne Road, Woodville.

The picture showed the massive blue brick railway bridge, which carried the old passenger railway line across Hartshorne Road from Woodville Station to Swadlincote as it was being demolished in the early 1980s.

The Swadlincote loop closed its regular service to passengers in 1947. After this date a great variety of excursion traffic continued to use the line. The most regular special workings were those to Derby County football matches which ran outward on Saturday lunchtimes or midweek evenings throughout the season, returning after the final whistle. Other frequent specials included a late Friday night holiday train to Blackpool during the summer months, with the return working mid-afternoon Saturday, often producing a pair of engines at the head of the train; on some occasions named locomotives were seen. Theatre trips, Sunday School outings and day trips to Skegness and Alton Towers were some of the other excursion destinations.
