## From the Diocese

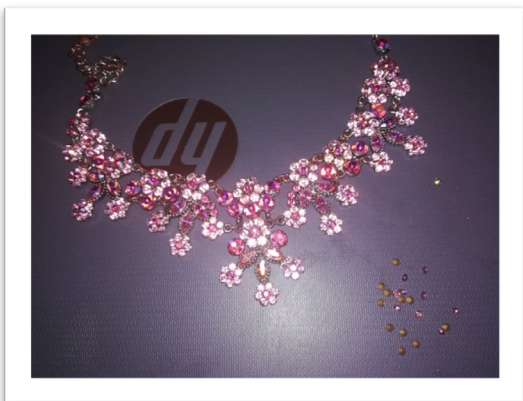
For those of us caring for children (not just parents but grandparents, aunts, uncles and others), there are resources from the Faith at

## From our Fellowship

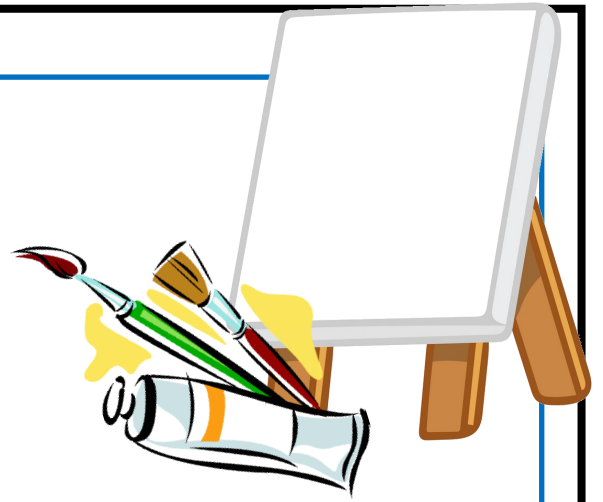


Melody has been learning the new skill of Jewellery repair and has managed to fix her absolute totally favourite old necklace and is feeling very pleased with herself!!



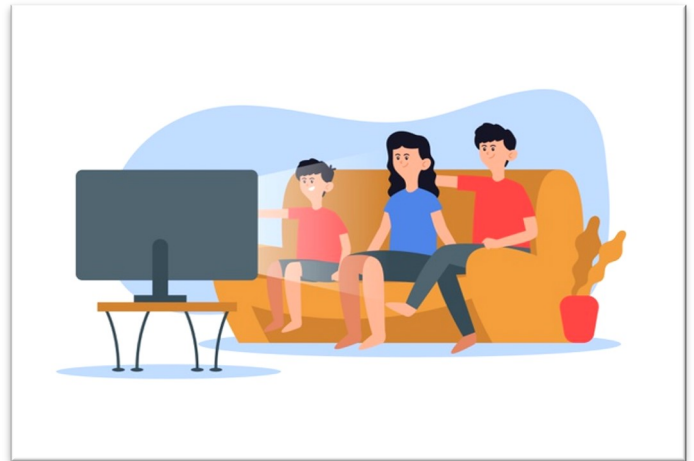
## From our Fellowship
