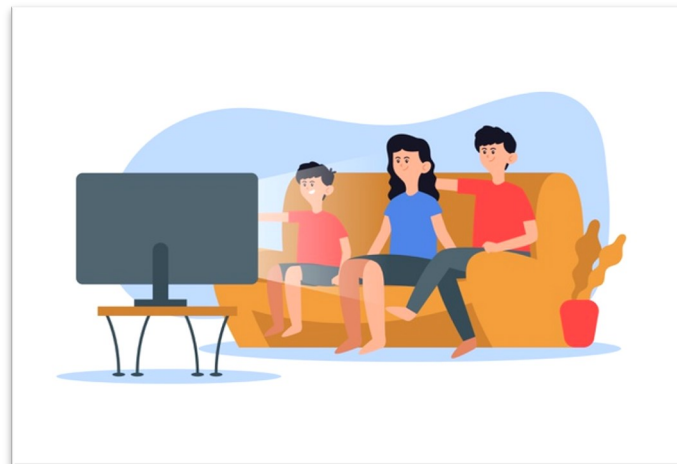
## Community impact
