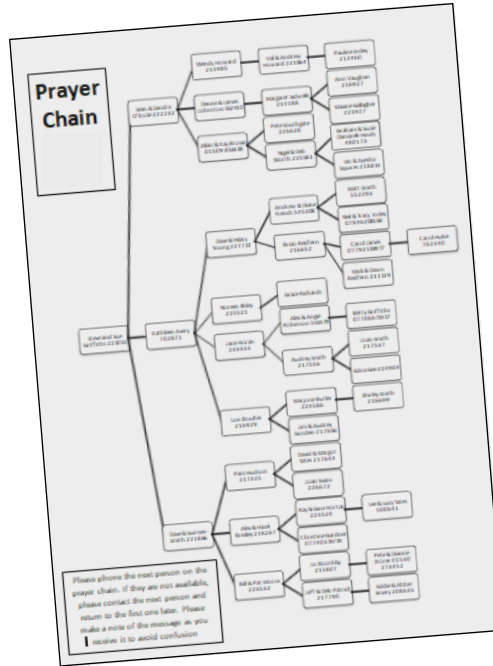

Shortly after I joined the church in the 1980s I was given an A4 sheet of paper - the PRAYER CHAIN.

## Prayer Chain



At that time mobile phones were a thing of the future and everyone just had a telephone and a pad of paper to take messages. The prayer chain was a bit like a family tree - Ian and Brenda at the top who then contacted two or three others with details of a prayer request they had received. Those people then had to contact two or three

other people with the message and so on until everyone had received the request for prayer. There were certain weaknesses in the chain - if someone didn't answer the phone then this meant trying again later or jumping to the person on the next level. Sometimes the message was not forwarded correctly or it was misheard (a bit like Chinese whispers!) So, when in 2012 we adopted the current method of passing on prayer requests via text message the whole operation became much simpler and more accurate.
