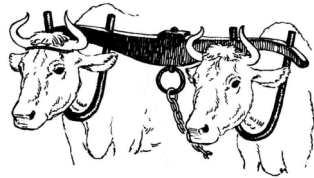
We ALL need to work together as the body of Christ.
