## Bell ringing

At St Peter's, the bells have been a big part of life for over 400 years, ringing out for all kinds of occasions, both joyous and solemn, and bringing the community together. But like many traditions, there were times when interest in ringing faded. Those breaks remind us how quickly traditions can slip away without people who care enough to keep them alive.

In 1960 the five bells were dismantled and stood at the base of the tower, waiting for sufficient funds to be raised for their restoration. Then, just over fifty years ago in 1974, the bells were restored, a sixth bell cast, and ringing started again. Twelve years ago, after a period of no regular ringing, a new band of ringers was formed with Andy Austen as tower captain. It was at this time that I was literally "roped in" and took up ringing again after a gap of 40 years.
