# Bell ringing

At St Peter's, the bells have been a big part of life for over 400 years, ringing out for all kinds of occasions, both joyous and solemn, and bringing the community together. But like many traditions, there were times when interest in ringing faded. Those breaks remind us how quickly traditions can slip away without people who care enough to keep them alive.

In 1960 the five bells were dismantled and stood at the base of the tower, waiting for sufficient funds to be raised for their restoration. Then, just over fifty years ago in 1974, the bells were restored, a sixth bell cast, and ringing started again. If you would like to read more about this have a look at this booklet that I wrote after reading all about it in the parish magazines

Twelve years ago, after a period of no regular ringing, a new band of ringers was formed with Andy Austen as tower captain. It was at this time that I was literally "roped in" and took up ringing again after a gap of 40 years.

We are always keen to welcome new ringers. If you would like to see us in action why not come along to a practice night? We meet at 7.30pm on Wednesday evenings.

Calls from fake police officers - Stop! Think Fraud.

We have received reports of a scam targeting Derbyshire homes, where the caller claims to be a police officer, giving names such as DC Sly and claiming to be from Scotland Yard.

They say they're investigating unauthorised use of the person's bank card and advises them to keep the call secret - a key tactic in fraud.

If you receive a call like this, never give out any person information and hang up the call immediately.
