

A thought from Debbie

Has anyone ever played string games? Maybe when you were at school.

To make the bridge you need to keep your hands in the right tension so that the string doesn't get too loose. Some fingers are staying in the same position... just keeping everything in the right place whilst others are working with the string to create the shape I am after...and if you get that all right you end up with a bridge.

I have been thinking about how important those first small communities of believers were in sharing their love for God. Living out the most important commandment ... To love God first and foremost... and then...to love our neighbour as much as we love ourselves... and the community grew; some doubting... some full of faith AND all growing in love and commitment to each other and God....each knowing their part and each holding those two commandments in just the right tension to build bridges between the God they loved and their neighbours.

Recipe - Moist apple cupcakes

This are great-tasting, moist apple cupcakes that are easy to make and a yummy way to use up extra apples.

- 5 apples peeled, cored and sliced
- 2 cups plain flour
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 4 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 4 teaspoons baking powder
- 4 large eggs
- 2 cups white sugar
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

- 1. Preheat the oven to 175 degrees C. Put 24 cake cases into muffin tins.
- 2. Sift flour, salt, cinnamon, and baking powder together; set aside.
- 3. Beat eggs and sugar together in a large bowl with an electric mixer on high speed until light in colour, about 2 to 3 minutes; beat in oil until combined. Add flour mixture and mix well. Add vanilla and fold in apples. Divide cake batter between 24 cake cases.
- 4. Bake in the preheated oven for 20 to 25 minutes.
